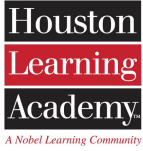

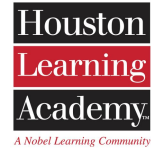

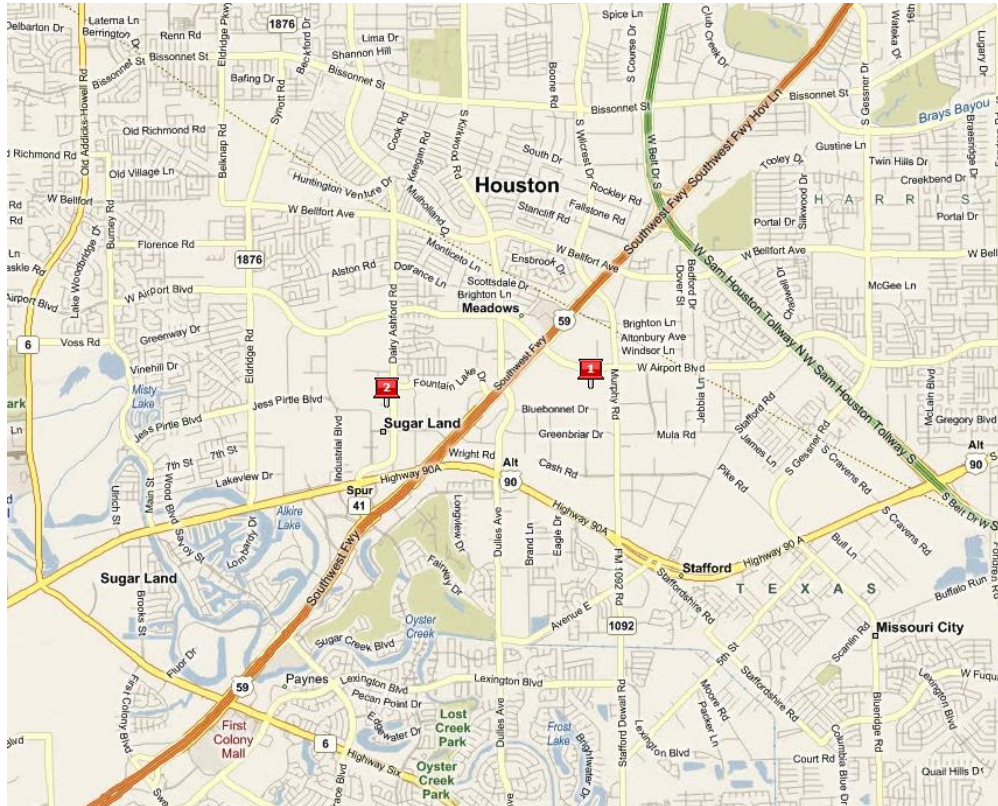

To HLA from Sugar Land using Hwy 59:

- 1) Take 59 North
- 2) Exit Kirkwood
- 3) Right on Kirkwood
- 4) Left at light (Bluebonnet)
- 5) HLA is at the end of street on left
3rd industrial business strip on left
Address: 3964 Bluebonnet

To Wharton Jr. College from Sugar Land:

- 1) Take Hwy 90 North or 59 North
- 2) Exit and Left on Dairy Ashford
- 3) Over the railroad tracks
- 4) Left on next street (Julie Rivers)
- 5) Through stop sign (Corporate Dr)
- 6) Wharton Jr. College on Right
Take second driveway & go to back to the 3rd building.

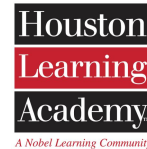
To HLA from Sugar Land using Hwy 90:

Houston Learning Academy Summer Policy



Enrollment constitutes acceptance of HLA, Fort Bend Campus school policies and decisions. Full payment for each class must be included. Check, money order or credit card for the amount of the course will secure your registration. There is a **\$100 charge for any class, campus or subject change once a student is registered. 50% refund may be given if written notice is received PRIOR to the start of the session. Once the session starts, there will be no refunds for cancellations.** Should we cancel a course for any reason; a full refund will be made. No refunds will be made for students that are dismissed because of attendance, suspension, or inappropriate behavior. Attendance is mandatory. Any class time lost due to an absence must be made up.

Registration and Books: Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. Registration form, fees, and signatures by all parties are mandatory for enrollment. Books are provided for the use of students but remain HLA and must be returned at the end of the session. Students are responsible for damaged or lost textbooks. Students must supply pen/pencil, a spiral notebook, calculator, or other supplies stated by teacher.

Attendance: Continuous attendance along with completion of all work and test are required. Due to state regulations, any student missing more than one class in a session will be dropped from the class without refund. HLA is a closed campus; students may not leave the building without the written consent of the student’s teacher and principal. A doctor or court order receipt with a signed parent’s note is necessary for an excused absence. A student’s unexcused absence make-up work will receive a maximum of 80% credit. Students must work and stay in their assigned class. Classes are dismissed by the school bell only.

Grades and Finals: Grades will only be granted when all student requirements are met. Students must complete all work assigned by the teacher, or zeros will be given for “refusal to work”. One-half credit will be granted for each subject passed. A minimum score of 70 is considered passing. The final exam is 25% of the grade. There are no student exemptions from final exams. Finals will be completed on the assigned day and time. Students MUST pass the final exam to receive credit for the course. A second final exam may be offered at the discretion of the administration for a fee of \$50. Grade reports will be mailed to their home and their home school after the second and fourth session. Each course offered is considered an “Academic” course and is weighted accordingly.

Curriculum: HLA follows Texas Assessment Knowledge & Skills (TAKS) and course requirements for a high school diploma. HLA does not offer Special Education or 504 Services.

Disclosure: Any special needs or circumstances must be discussed with the principal at the time of registration.

Attire: The attire of all students must be neat, clean and modest. The judgment of the appropriateness of attire rests with the principal or admin supervisor. Blue jeans, shorts, t-shirts, and sandals are acceptable. The following are unacceptable: tank tops, halter tops, strapless tops, spandex, cut offs, questionable printing/slogans, and obvious distractions. Shorts and dresses

must be no higher than mid thigh. Attire must fully cover the abdomen and back. Students inappropriately dressed may be sent home as an unexcused absence. All clothing must fit neatly.

Substance-Free Campus: HLA will not tolerate substance abuse. Possession of any substance or drug (prescription/non prescription drugs, alcohol, or tobacco) within 500 feet radius of the campus is cause for immediate expulsion without refund. **Director, security personnel or authorized teacher has the right to search any student and their possessions if reasonable or probable cause exists. A student will be suspended if appearance or smell of substance use is suspected at any time.**

Disciplinary Action: Disciplinary action will be taken immediately for a student’s disrespect, defiance, profanity, disruption, verbal or physical abuse, cheating, truancy, theft, malicious mischief, reckless driving in the parking lot, unauthorized departure, and other conduct or acts deemed unacceptable by HLA or law authorities. All cell phones must be turned off during class time. Students shall not possess devices of radios, tapes, videos, CD, or electronic equipment. Parents may reclaim student’s property for a \$15 FEE. Food and drinks cannot be brought to or consumed in class. Students cannot distribute or solicit items, pamphlets, events or services.

Parking Lot: Students and vehicles in the immediate campus area, including visual site, are under HLA rules and regulations. No student parking is allowed in red “Staff” zones or in front of any other offices. Safe driving in the parking lot is 5 MPH. Students should enter the facility immediately and not remain in the parking lot. Unsafe driving in the parking lot is cause for dismissal without refund.

Service Charges:

- (1) \$100 fee will be assessed for class, campus or subject changes.
- (2) 50% refund may be given if written notice is received PRIOR to the start of the session.
- (3) A \$25 fee will be assessed for NSF checks. An NSF check will result in the student being placed on financial suspension and grades will not be released until restitution is made.
- (4) NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN ONCE A SESSION HAS BEGUN.
